2022 RAMBEAUX PINOT NOIR


Born from the Dusky Goose tradition, Rambeaux wines are both sophisticated and inviting, delivering the quality you expect from our winemaking team and vineyard sources.



The 2022 vintage began with a long, wet winter, and bud break was met with a frost event that set the growing season back by nearly a month. Once the vines recovered, warm and dry conditions held steady through mid-October, giving the fruit time to fully ripen before the fall rains arrived. While yields were down approximately 40% due to the frost, the fruit we harvested was exceptional—concentrated, balanced, and expressive.

Tasting Notes

Vivid aromatics of dark cherry, raspberry jam, black tea, and pressed flowers, with subtle hints of dried herbs. The palate is bright and refined, showcasing a vibrant red fruit profile with flavors of wild strawberry. Soft tannins provide structure, while a layer of minerality adds depth and complexity. The finish is elegant and lingers with spice notes and a delicate earthiness.
